2.	The Baltimore Screenwriters Competition is open to all screenwriters. Screenplays must be set in Baltimore or 75% filmable in Baltimore. Scripts must be written in US Motion Picture industry standard format; typed in 12 pt. Courier font; printed on white paper; bound with brass fasteners; cardstock covers.				
	FEATURE FILM SCRIPTS: Aproximately 85-120 pages SHORT FILM SCRIPTS: Must not exceed 30 pages.

4.	Each entry must consist of one hard copy and one electronic copy or three hard copies of the screenplay. Entries with less than three hard copies or no electronic copy will not be accepted for consideration.				
5.	To assure your scripts anonymity through the judging process,

	(address, script registration number, etc.) on the title page or				
	anywhere in your script.				
6.	An entry form and entry fee must accompany each screenplay.
